We have underlined and highlighted the words in verse 7 ... <u>Every man according as he purposeth in</u> <u>his heart, so let him give</u>; This was an offering above the tithe. Such offerings are taught as being for the poor, or special needs and for missions. For 49 years I personally have been involved in giving by faith and making a promise, knowing God will provide. If we <u>1.</u> get excited about giving (notice the word "*cheerful* in verse 7); <u>2</u>. seeing the need we "*purpose*", plan to give; <u>3</u>; As we give, read verse 6, God will provide abounding grace, that will be sufficient for every good work, read verse 8.
