WORD of the DAY - "HALLEJUAH"

- Hallelujah" is a combination of two Hebrew words: "hallel," meaning "to praise," and "Yah," a shortened form of Yahweh, God's name.
- **Usage in Psalms:** The word appears frequently in the Book of Psalms, particularly at the beginning or end of psalms praising God.
- **Usage in Revelation:** In Revelation 19:1-6, a great multitude in heaven uses "Hallelujah" to praise God for His judgments, His victory over evil, and His eternal reign.
- **Significance:** "Hallelujah" is a powerful expression of praise and worship, signifying joy, gratitude, and recognition of God's sovereignty.

Scripture for Today - Revelation 19:1-6;

- 1** And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:
- 2** For true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.
- 3** And again they said, Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever.
- 4** And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.
- 5** And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great.
- 6** And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.
