For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. Psalm 139; 13, 14;

At 4 weeks - The heart, now in a tubular form, begins to beat by the 25th day.

At 6 weeks - Electrical activity begins developing brain and nervous system.

At 6 weeks - Arms, legs, hands, toes and face begin to form. The baby begins small random movements.

[A Doctor described a baby in a tubal pregnancy (again 6 weeks, because after that, the tube ruptures). The Doctor said he saw the baby swimming around in the sac once a second with a natural swimmers stroke].

At 10 weeks - The heart can be detected electronically.

At 12 weeks - The baby is able to swallow and the kidneys are able to make urine. Blood begins to form in the bone marrow.

At 16 weeks- The baby can kick and sleep.

At 28 weeks - The baby has lungs that can breathe air.

At 32 weeks - the baby can grasp firmly.

At 38 weeks - The baby has reached full term and is ready to be born.

A 40 weeks - Mom hopes the baby will be born SOON.
